Session 1	July 1 – July 12

All lesson sessions are 9 days, with the last Friday used as a “rain out” day if needed or “fun day”.

*TBA – every session we have certain levels fill and waiting lists develop. These time slots have been reserved for those levels that we need to open up another class for. The level will be decided upon prior to the session.

Swim Program Levels

Program	Description
Sea Otter	This is our semi-parented level. Child is 3–5yrs and able to move forwards and backwards assisted, front, back floats and recover assisted, uses buoyant objects for support.
Salamander	Child is 3-5 yrs old, put face in water move and float w/ assistance, transitional level, 30 min.
Sunfish	Child is 3-5 yrs old, work on strokes and skills progressions; entries and floats in deep water, 30 min.
Crocodile	Child is 3 - 5 yrs old, independent glides and kicking in deep water; build endurance by distance swims, 30 min.
Whale	Child is 3 - 5 yrs old, swim independently and participate in team games, improve front and back swim skills, 30 min.
Level 1	Child is 6 yrs old; entry level orientation to the water; introduces floats and glides with kicks, 30 min.
Level 2	Second orientation level, builds skills in front and back swims; introduction to deep water activities, 30 min.
Level 3	Introduction to front crawl; diving is introduced; work on floats and changing direction; 15m swim, 30 min.
Level 4	Front crawl, back glide and shoulder roll for back crawl are further developed; 25m swim, 30 min.
Level 5	Back crawl is introduced; sculling skills and whip kick on back; safe boating skills, dolphin kick, 50m swim, 45 min. (note new time)
Level 6	Elementary backstroke is introduced; safety on ice, throwing assists, treading water, front dive, 75m swim, 45 min.
Level 7	Introduces whip kick on the front, builds skills for front crawl, airway & breathing obstructions, 150m swim, 45 min.
Level 8	Introduction to breaststroke, foot first surface dives, & rescue entries, dolphin kick endurance, 300m swim, 45 min.
Level 9	Refinement of front crawl, back crawl, elementary backstroke and breaststroke, standing dives, 400m swim, 60 min.
Level 10	Introduction of butterfly, refinement of strokes, head-first & feet-first shallow dives, sun safety, 500m swim, 60 min.

Botanical Gardens of Silver Springs:

The gardens have had a wonderful start thanks to the volunteer gardeners. Beds are flourishing and producing wonderful blooms. July brings the end of the spring flowers, the alpine garden is much less showy and the heat of the summer encourages blooms. Come to the garden and enjoy the rose garden where you will see over 90 different species both in the designated garden and throughout the larger garden.

One garden that is worth some time to investigate is the low H2O garden which highlights plants that require minimal watering. As the summers heat up, we need more and more to choose plants that do not require frequent watering. The garden has many plants that thrive in this environment, some are showy blooms and some are quieter in their displays. All of these plants thrive in the northwest of Calgary. Currently on our website at <https://www.bgss.ca/search> you can see each of the plants in the low H2O garden with information on them, and where else in the garden you can find them. Each plant biography contains the scientific and common name, the zone where it will grow and some information on how to treat the plant. Coming soon will be a bar code for each garden which will aid in your search.

The wall garden has a wonderful microclimate and supports plants from zone 4 easily and occasionally one from zone 5. Walk the length of the garden and see the different plants that can be grown in Calgary although some of them do require some special consideration.

The garden can provide tours with special arrangement. Please contact us through the website if you are interested. Tours for the public will be on our events calendar on the website. www.bgss.ca

Enjoy each of the 19 gardens in your own way, appreciate the gift of flowers, enjoy the quiet time in the Shakespeare Garden or the labyrinth. Note the fruit trees and bushes that can grow here in the fruit grove. Maps are at each end of the garden to help you identify and navigate. We welcome all. The garden is open every day and there is no charge. Donations are gratefully accepted.

The Silver Springs Edible Garden is enjoying another season of veggie growing and community building in the beautiful neighbourhood of Silver Springs. Gardeners are beginning to enjoy some of their early crops and are nurturing those that will be harvested later this season.

The Silver Springs Edible Garden Group, in partnership with the Botanical Gardens of Silver Springs, proudly offered the 'Growing Connection' Garden Speaker Series again in 2019 – a series of public speaking events featuring different gardening topics. Our final presentation for this year took place on June 19th with a great turnout. Jean-Mathieu Daoust, a certified arborist with 'Tree Frog Tree Care' (Division of 'Bartlett Tree Experts'), presented 'The 'Right Way' to Prune Trees and Shrubs'. The interactive presentation covered a general overview of tree care from root to shoot, basic pruning, tree biology, watering, fertilizing, pest control, tree plants, species selection and placement.

How to Store Summer Garden Vegetables

When your load of summer veggies is ready to harvest, it can be a little overwhelming! Here are a few tips to help prolong the life and flavour of your summer harvest:

1. Leave the stems attached. The stem on veggies like cucumbers, peppers, and squash helps to protect against bacteria.
2. Wash veggies only when you are ready to use them. If you wash them too early, any excess moisture can cause the vegetable to go bad more quickly.
3. Put ripe peppers, summer squash, green beans, and cantaloupe in the fridge but ...
4. Store ripe tomatoes, eggplants, cucumbers, okra, and watermelon in a cool, humid place – these veggies just can't handle to the chilliness of the fridge!

Bowmont Park Corner: Our Little Gem in the Heart of Silver Springs

Usually, the summer months rhymes with construction and this is true for Bowmont Park as well. Work will continue for the Dale Hodges Park in the east end and also for the fish habitat improvement in the west end. Some work will also be underway regarding slopes stabilisation and enhancing native vegetation. The good news is that none of this work should not lead to any pathway closure this year! However to make sure, check the city webpage as it 'should' be up to date: calgary.ca/bowmontpark.

Planning on picking some Saskatoon berries in Bowmont Park this summer? Have you heard of *Echinococcus multilocularis*? This is a tapeworm parasite carried by coyotes and rodent in Bowmont Park. Transmission to human is rare but consequences can be serious. It is spread through little eggs (not visible to the naked eye) present in the affected animal feces. It is advised to wash berries with soap and water before eating them. And maybe choose taller bushes and educate your children about it.
