June	Family BBQ	14	Cooks, station supervisors (craft table, bouncy castle, climbing wall), event set up and take down.
September	Children's Used Clothing/Toy Sale	3	Supervisory, event set up and take down.
November	Crafter's Market	4	Concession operation, event set up and take down.
December	Breakfast with Santa	14	Cooks, food station servers, event set up and take down.
Ongoing (February, June, October, December)	Jelly Bean Dances	3	Parent volunteers to help with supervision.

COMMITTEES

Casino Fundraiser Volunteers (occurs every 18 months)

About 45 volunteers of 4-8 hour shifts are needed to successfully run our Casino Fundraiser for 2018. There are various positions – banker, cashier, chip runner, etc., must be 18 years or older. Come out, have some fun and help our community association raise much needed funds for community capital projects!

Skating Rink Volunteers (occurs annually October to March, weather dependent)

Sweepers and shoveling are needed, no experience required, only a keen will to keep the ice in great condition for skating! About 8 teams of volunteers with 3-4 people per team is required for morning and evening shifts, time commitment varies but is generally once per week.

Community Clean Up (occurs annually in June or September)

Help your neighbours unload recycling and garbage at the drop off location, approximately 10 people are required the day of. Skip your workout this day some lifting will be required!

Board of Directors (Nominations are sought in the Fall and conclude ahead of the Annual General Meeting in January)

Board Members are needed to keep our community going! Directors are unpaid volunteers, who must be members in good standing of the SSCA, willing to devote at least 1-2 hours per week to collaborate with other directors and members on any of the committee's according to expertise and availability. The minimum requirements for a Director is to stay informed about the issues in committee, attend the monthly meetings of the Board (excludes July and August) and any general meetings of the memberships, including the Annual General Meeting. Time commitment varies. There are several community committees that provide the City of Calgary and the SSCA with valuable input. If you have passion for your community your talents are critically needed.

Botanical Gardens

Volunteers are always needed and welcome - and you do not have to have a green thumb or special skills! All that is required is the willingness to be part of a project dedicated to making our world a little greener and more beautiful.
